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School Vision & Mission

According to the College Deed of 1821, the objective of Ying Wa College was the reciprocal cultivation of English and Chinese literature and the diffusion of Christianity. These aims remain today in the context of a very different world.

A. Our School

1. Brief History of Ying Wa College

Ying Wa College traces her history back to the Anglo-Chinese College founded in Malacca by Rev. Robert Morrison of the London Missionary Society in 1818. The mission of the school was the reciprocal cultivation of English and Chinese literature and the diffusion of Christianity. She trained students to be well versed in both Chinese and Western cultures, so as to help spread the gospel in China.

In 1843 when Hong Kong became the colony of Britain, Rev. James Legge brought the school to Hong Kong where she continued her educational, translation, and publishing activities. Since then, the school had experienced various internal and external difficulties, leading to repeated instances of closure and then reopening with renewed vigor. At present, Ying Wa remains as one of the schools having the longest history in Hong Kong.

2. Sponsoring Body

Ying Wa College is an Anglo-Chinese secondary school for boys. She was originally founded by the London Missionary Society. When the London Missionary Society ended her mission in China, the school was affiliated with the Hong Kong Council of the Church of Christ in China, Hong Kong Chapter.

3. Board of Directors

The Ying Wa College School Management Committee Limited was set up in 2009 to meet the need of DSS. There are now altogether 19 members in the Board of Directors including 10 members elected by and representing the Hong Kong Council of the Church of Christ in China, 2 members elected by and representing the Ying Wa College Old Boys' Association, 1 teacher representative, 1 parent representative, the Principal and 4 independent members.

6. Improvement Projects

The following improvement works was done in 2011-2012 school year:

- (1) The repair work of the 3/F corridor and the renovation work of student changing room were completed in April.
- (2) The renovation of partial basketball court and football court surfaces was carried out and completed in June.
- (3) The improvement work of flushing water supply system was done, the new ventilation ducts were built and new ventilation fans were installed for all the toilets.
- (4) The gardening water pipe on ground floor was replaced to fix the leakage problem.
- (5) The renovation of the Art Room side benches and sinks was completed in August.
- (6) Slip-resistant treatment was done on tiles at College Entrance, on G/F, 1/F, 2/F, 3/F and 7/F to enhance safety of students and teachers in humid weather.

B. Our Students

1. Class Organization and Enrolment

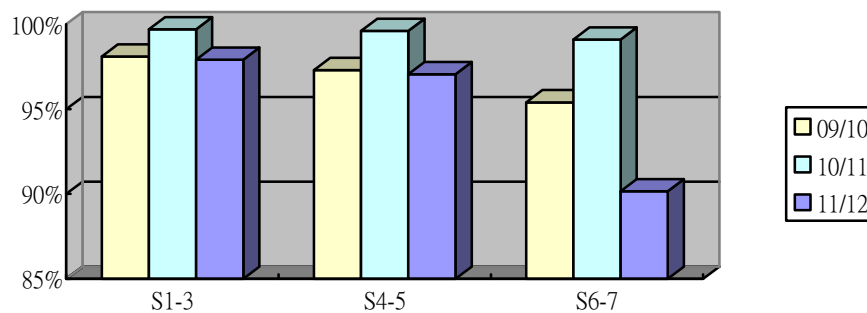
The academic year 2011-2012 began with a total of 1245 students registered for 35 classes including 5 classes in each form from S1 to S3 and S5 to S6, 7 classes in S4 and 3 classes in S7.

There were 74 DSS students in S1, 74 in S2, 54 in S3 and 53 in S4, accounting for 20.5% of the student population.

2. Students' Attendance

The students' attendance rate was satisfactory. The attendance rates of S1-S3, S4-S5 and S6-S7 were 99.7%, 99.6% and 99.1% respectively.



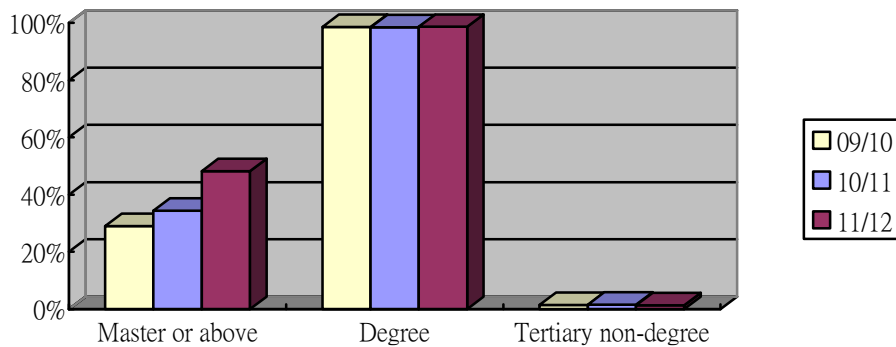
3. Students' Early Exit

At the end of the school year, a total number of 62 students recorded left. Most of them chose to further their studies abroad. The drop-off rate was 5%.

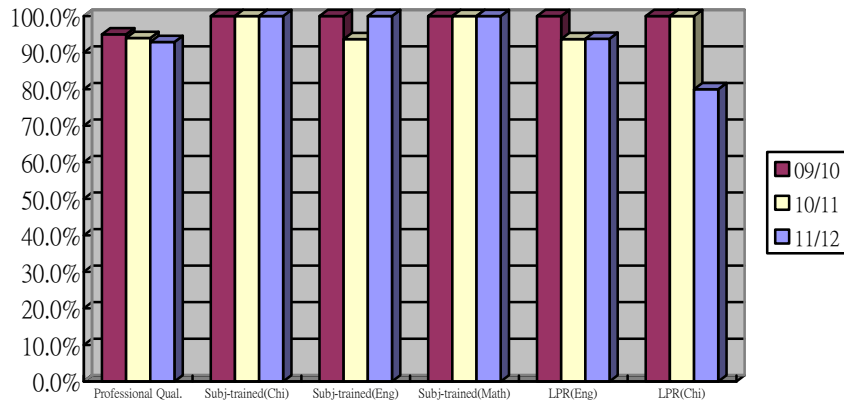
C. Our Teachers

1. Teachers' Qualification

According to the approved structure, the School was entitled to have 63 teachers (including the Principal) and 1 Native-speaking English Teacher. On top of that, we employed 2 additional NETs and 17 additional teachers with the school fund. 98.8% of our teachers are graduates from university with 40 teachers holding a master degree.

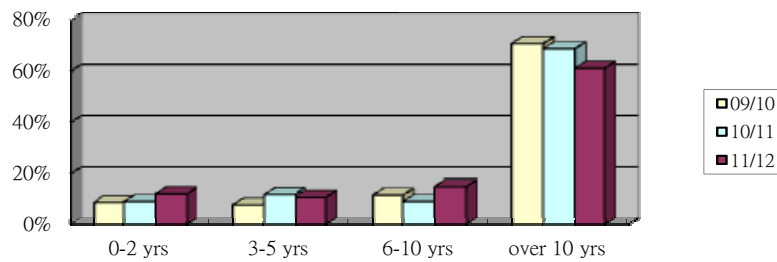


Over 90% of our teachers have received professional training in Education. All teachers teaching Chinese and Mathematics are subject-trained. All teachers teaching Putonghua have fulfilled the Language Proficiency Requirement.

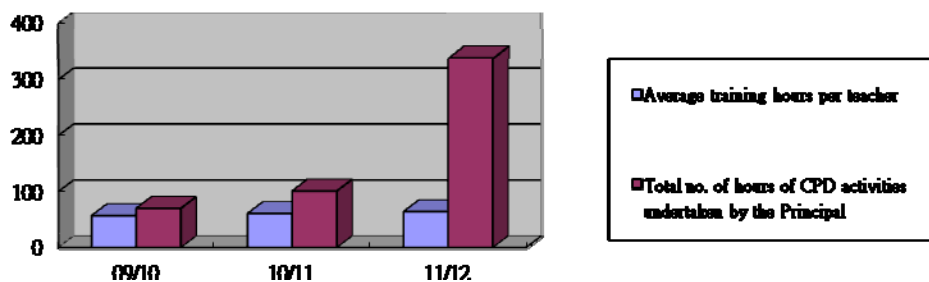


2. Teachers' Experience

Our teachers are professional and dedicated. 54.8% of them have over 10 years of teaching experience.



3. Teachers' Professional Development



Before the start of the academic year 2011-2012, 20 new teachers attended a whole day 'New Teacher Induction' workshop to familiarize themselves with Ying Wa culture, school features, school policies and interrelationship between teachers, students and parents. They also received information technology (IT) training. A mentor was assigned for each new teacher. Several lunch gatherings with new teachers were also held throughout the year.

In September, teachers in the middle management level participated in two sessions of 'Instructional Leadership: Quality School Improvement Plan' workshop. The workshop was conducted by Mr CHAN Tak-hang. The topics were 'How to conduct a good lesson?' and 'Peer observation'. After the workshop, subject panels shared the skills and knowledge learnt with their subject panel members. Teachers then conducted peer observation in their major teaching subject. Experts from the CUHK-QSIP team came to our school afterwards

for lesson observation, and shared their valuable advice with our teachers.

In the first term, Dr. CHIU Chi-shing, conducted two workshops for all staff. The topics were ‘Strategies in small class teaching’ and ‘Applying questioning skills in small class teaching’.

A ‘Joint school Ying Wa Staff Professional Development Day’ on Through Train Development was launched on 2 April, 2012. In the morning, Mr. CHAN Kin-hung, our Education Director reported on ‘Ying Wa Through Train Education Development Plan’; Dr. FUNG Chun-yip shared several case studies in Mathematics teaching with teachers; Dr. Ho Man-kwun shared case studies in Chinese Language. In the afternoon, teachers from both the College and the Primary School sections discussed the strategies in collaboration and bridging in their teaching subjects in groups.

On 27 April, 2012, Dr. CHIU Chi-shing shared several cases with us on ‘Lesson observation with focuses on small class teaching and catering for learning diversity’. Teachers benefited much. Our colleague, Mr. CHOI Kam-to shared his teaching strategies with us.

In June, 2012, Mr. CHAN Kin-hung, our Education Director conducted three seminars with teachers in the middle management level on ‘Administration and Management’. We benefited much.

In year 2011-2012, the total no. of hours of CPD activities undertaken by the Acting Principal were 340 hours and the average training hours per teacher were 64.09 hours.

4. Staff Turnover Rate

At the end of the academic year, 16 teachers left Ying Wa. Mr. BOOK Kwok-chee and Mr. CHAN Ip-cheung retired after serving Ying Wa for 34 and 36 years respectively. The school gave thanks to them for their contribution to the school and wish them all the best.

The turnover rate was 19.05%. The turnover rates for the past 3 years are as follows:

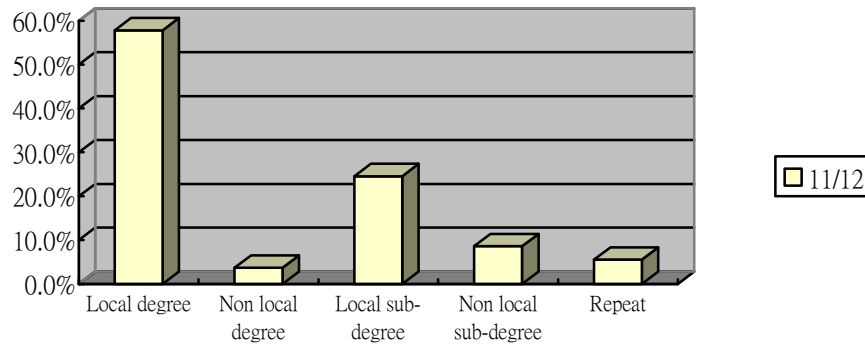

1. Graduates' Pathways

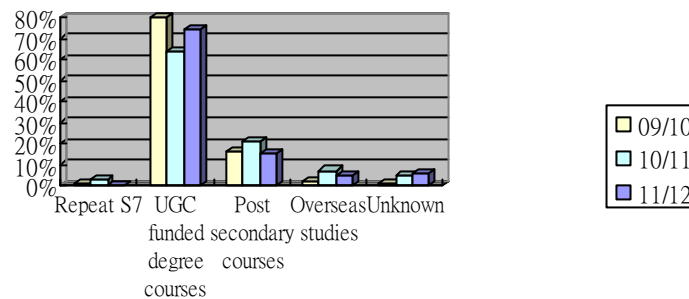
Most of our S6 graduates are offered degrees and sub-degrees, either local or overseas. In 2011-2012, the rate was 94.5%.

S6 Graduates



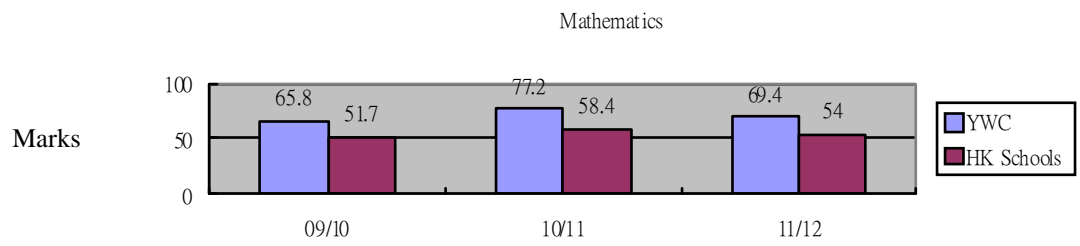
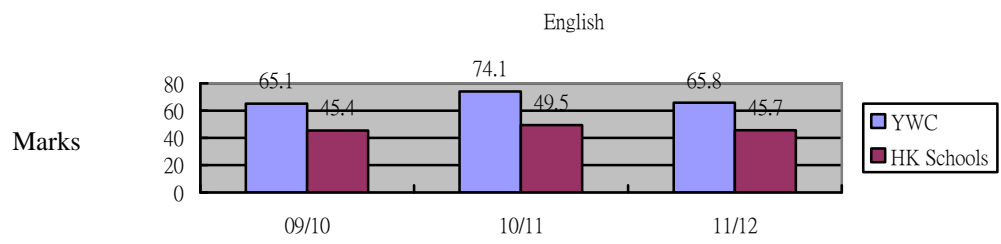
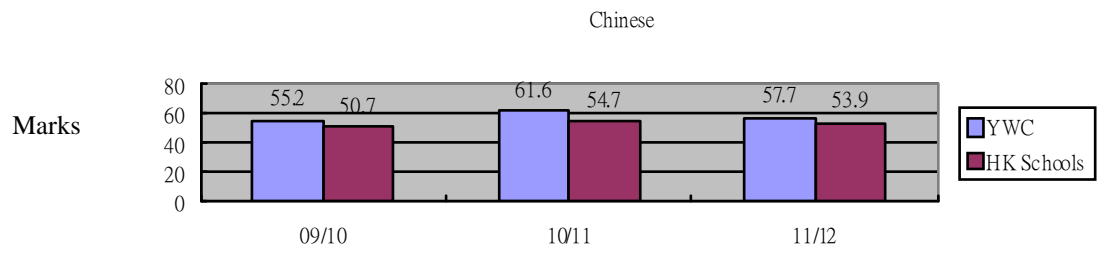
Most of our S7 graduates continue their studies either in local universities, local tertiary institutes or overseas universities. In 2011-2012, the rate was 97.8%.

G. Student Support

1. Evangelistic Work

With the mission to bring our students to Christ, there are student fellowship, morning devotion and morning prayers in our school. Guests and ministers of Ying Wa Church are invited to deliver sermons in the evangelistic morning assemblies. In addition, the Gospel Week and the Gospel Camp are held every year so that our Lord Jesus Christ can be introduced to our students in various ways.

The Gospel Week was held in November 2011. The programmes included evangelistic morning assemblies, gospel meetings, individual preaching and sermons. 436 students decided to follow Christ and reconfirmed their faith.

The Summer Gospel Camp was held from 8 July to 10 July 2012 at the Salvation Army - Bradbury Camp, Cheung Chau. After the camp, around 80% of the campers attended Ying Wa Church.

Some Ying Wa boys joined a mission trip during the summer holiday in Middle East & India. They conducted a series of programmes for local students and introduced Christ to them.

We must express our gratitude to Rev. Dr. Cheng Yee-Sum, Pastor-in-charge of Ying Wa Church, for serving Ying Wa as our College Chaplain. We also thank Mr. Yap See-Kiang, Minister of Ying Wa Church, and many brothers and sisters of Ying Wa Church, for their great contribution to the Gospel Week, Gospel Camp, morning prayers and fellowship. May the Lord be glorified and His blessing be with us.
