### SCHOOL REPORT 2022-2023

#### A. Our School

### 1. Brief History of Ying Wa College

Ying Wa College traces her history back to the Anglo-Chinese College founded in Malacca by Rev Robert Morrison of the London Missionary Society in 1818. The mission of the school was the reciprocal cultivation of English and Chinese literature and the diffusion of Christianity. She trained students to be well versed in both Chinese and Western cultures, to help spread the gospel in China.

In 1843 when Hong Kong became the colony of Britain, Rev. James Legge brought the school to Hong Kong where she continued her educational, translation, and publishing activities. Since then, the school had experienced various internal and external difficulties, leading to repeated instances of closure and then reopening with renewed vigor. At present, Ying Wa remains one of the schools having the longest history in Hong Kong with outstanding performance in various areas.

#### 2. Sponsoring Body

Ying Wa College is an Anglo-Chinese secondary school for boys. She was originally founded by the London Missionary Society. When the London Missionary Society ended her mission in China, the school was affiliated with the Hong Kong Council of the Church of Christ in China, Hong Kong Chapter.

#### 3. Board of Directors

The Ying Wa College School Management Committee Limited was set up in 2009 to meet the need of DSS. There are now altogether 18 members in the Board of Directors including 10 members elected by and representing the Hong Kong Council of the Church of Christ in China, 3 members elected by and representing the Ying Wa College Old Boys' Association, 1 teacher representative, 1 parent representative, the Principal and 2 independent members.

#### 1. Class Organization and Enrolment


The academic year 2022-2023 began with a total of 1017 students registered for 35 operating classes.

There were 205 DSS students in S1, 197 in S2, 171 in S3, 168 in S4, 145 in S5 and 131 in S6, accounting for 100% of the student population.

#### 2. Students' Attendance




#### C. Our Teachers

#### 1. Teachers' Qualification

The College has a strong team of 90 dedicated and professional teachers, including 2 NET teachers and 1 resource teacher to support classroom teaching and student development initiatives. All of our teachers are graduates from university with 40 teachers holding at least one master's degree.




Over 90% of our teachers have received professional training in Education. All teachers teaching Chinese, English and Mathematics are subject-trained.




#### 2. Teachers' Experience

#### 3. Teachers' Professional Development



Before the start of the academic year 2022-23, 8 new teachers attended a whole day induction workshop to familiarize themselves with Ying Wa culture as well as school measures and policies. Our student ambassadors gave a warm welcome to them and introduced our school campus. A mentor was assigned to each new teacher. New teachers also attended a "newly-employed teacher's forum" organized by HKCCCC later on. CCC schools vision, mission and core values were shared.

A staff development day was held in November to formulate a new school 5 year plan. Firstly, Principal introduced the road Ying Wa had walked in the past, all teaching staff then actively participated in the activities, gave out their opinions and voiced their concern about the vision and mission of Ying Wa. Later, school collected all opinions and drafted out a coming 5 year Ying Wa plan. Besides, a clinical psychologist from Kwai Chung Hospital was invited to the school to give a lecture and share information on mental health.

In February, in order to enable teaching staff to respond more appropriately to various emergencies. The Hong Kong Fire Services Department and the Government Flying Services co-organized the course at Fire and Ambulance Services Academy, Tseung Kwan O, to provide teachers with training on CPR, fire hose and fire extinguisher use, and explanations of emergency rescue and helicopter rescue safety guidelines for mountain activities.

The e-learning workshop, which was canceled last school year due to the epidemic, was successfully held in May to allow teachers to understand the latest teaching software and BYOD implementation strategies.

In the school year 2022-23, the total number of hours of CPD activities undertaken by the Principal was 120 hours and the average training hours per teacher were 43.7 hours. The training on the Basic Law is 8.7 hours on average.

#### 4. Staff Turnover Rate

At the end of the academic year, 9 teachers (except for Assistant Teachers and Substitute Teachers) left Ying Wa or retired. The College expressed her gratitude to them for their contribution to the school and wished them all the best.

The turnover rate was 10.2%. The turnover rates for the past 3 years are as follows:

## D. Major Concerns

#### **Major Concern 1: Purposeful Learning**

#### Achievements

The educational philosophy of "Purposeful Learning" has been successfully introduced, implemented, and embedded into teachers' and students' daily routines. In each subject, efforts have been made to connect students' learning experiences with real-life applications and their career aspirations. Specific learning outcomes are clearly articulated in lessons and assignments, ensuring a tangible link between classroom instruction and practical knowledge.

Through the comprehensive implementation of Learner-oriented Assessment (LoA) across all subjects, teachers establish a transparent connection between what students learn and how they are assessed in evaluations, including Assessment for Learning (AfL) and Assessment as Learning (AaL). At the outset of each teaching module, learning objectives and expected outcomes are outlined. Student assignments are thoughtfully designed to reflect these anticipated learning outcomes. Rubrics that describe the desired knowledge, skills, and attitudes are adopted to assess student performance.

Furthermore, students are not only encouraged to set their personal learning goals, fostering self-directed learning, but also asked to support one another in their learning journeys. Students engage in self-evaluation and peer evaluation, utilizing the rubrics as a valuable resource. This collaborative approach fosters a dynamic and supportive learning environment where students actively participate in their own growth and development.

In terms of academic achievement, the results of the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE) examinations have shown remarkable improvement when compared to previous years. The percentage of students meeting the university entrance requirements has surged to 90%, with 50% of S6 graduates receiving offers from the top three universities in Hong Kong (the University of Hong Kong, the Chinese University of Hong Kong, and the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology).

These achievements demonstrate the positive outcomes resulting from the successful implementation of strategies related to the major concern.

#### Reflection

Overall, the set targets have been successfully met, yielding positive outcomes. However, upon reflection on the achievements, it becomes evident that several areas require further refinement and attention.

One such area pertains to students' attitudes towards reading. Despite concerted efforts to promote and support reading, there is an acknowledgment that room exists for improvement. The belief is that by enhancing promotional and support measures, a greater enthusiasm for reading can be instilled

among the student body. Reading, not only as a fundamental skill but also as a gateway to knowledge, is deserving of a deeper appreciation among our students.

On a broader scale, students have exhibited a positive response to the educational philosophy of purposeful learning. This philosophy encourages students to transcend the boundaries of rote memorization and examination-centered learning, emphasizing the acquisition of knowledge for the sake of curiosity and intellectual growth. However, it is crucial to acknowledge that the challenges posed by the pandemic, including the intermittent shift between physical and online lessons, have impacted the overall effectiveness of this educational approach.

The gradual return to a normal lesson arrangement has provided an opportunity for students to reorient their focus, moving beyond mere examination-oriented learning to a more profound pursuit of knowledge. As we proceed, there is a commitment to refining strategies to ensure that the educational philosophy of purposeful learning remains prominent, offering our students a comprehensive and enriching educational experience.

### Feedback and Follow-up

The College is committed to sustaining its commitment to the promotion of reading through both physical books and e-reading initiatives in the upcoming school year. While the principles of LOA have already been seamlessly integrated into our daily teaching and learning practices, the College remains dedicated to further promoting these principles to enhance students' engagement and the overall effectiveness of their learning experiences.

### **Major Concern 2: Positive School**

#### Achievements

Targets in Major Concern 2 which is fundamental to the character building of our students were achieved. With mass education programs included in various functional committees to address topics relate to positive values, 7 learning goals were introduced to students.

Character strengths and other concepts in positive education were integrated into both academic and non-academic areas. Besides the project titled "Flourishing Teens" with class-based workshops being held in S1, S2 and S6 to develop students' better understanding of their character strengths, programs like Morning Boosters, S1 orientation activities, "Ying Wa Circle" – the praying group, Student Council Election, Inter-class cleanliness competition, Decency Award Scheme, Student Caring Scheme, Remnants, Guidance Ambassadors, Sham Shui Po Outstanding Youth Volunteer Scheme Award, Orbis Student Ambassador Scheme etc. were organized successfully for cultivating students' positive attributes, developing students' potential and forging brotherhood.

While access to lectures on National Security Education was shared with parents through push messages of eClass, parents' workshops on career planning, support to students with SEN, positive parenting, social workers' workshops etc. were conducted face-to-face and online with positive feedbacks received from parents. The effectiveness of our work mentioned above was shown through the APASO results as our students did well in various areas including no fear of failure, satisfaction and meaning of life etc.

#### Reflection

Following the PIME cycle carefully is the key factor of the encouraging results. Annual plan of each program was drafted before implementation. Monitoring was done pre-, while- and post-program. At the end of each program, evaluation was done to collect feedback which was used to inform the future planning. Besides survey, observation of teachers and parents would be counted for evaluation.

#### Feedback and Follow-up

The new school development plan will build on the successful parts in Major Concern 2. Positive values and well-being will continue to remain an important part for the good of students.

A school-based values statement based on Christian Faith with reference to EDB's corresponding framework will be developed to meet the developmental needs of our students in the new school plan.

A form-based student development program will be introduced to further strengthen our work on student development.

#### **Major Concern 3: Serving Community**

#### Achievements

Service-learning was seamlessly integrated into our program, offering a wide range of service-related opportunities to students across different levels. Specifically, students in S.4 were introduced to service-learning with an emphasis on design thinking, which helped them gain a deep and comprehensive understanding of the unique needs within our community and empowered them to create tailored solutions for these target groups.

The efforts to promote service through uniform groups yielded remarkable results, with a substantial increase in student participation. Members of uniform groups, including scouts and the Red Cross, actively participated in various in-school and outside school services. Among these groups, the Interact Club distinguished itself as the school's service club with the highest membership, underscoring students' genuine enthusiasm for community service initiatives. The Community Youth Club also organized different activities such as Fund-raising through plants selling.

The Service-learning Committee orchestrated a series of highly successful school-wide service projects, including the Consumption Voucher Sharing program, the Canned Food Sharing initiative, and collaborative Scarf-knitting classes in partnership with the Parent-Teacher Association. These initiatives received widespread acclaim, reflecting our unwavering commitment to serving our community and fostering a culture of compassionate engagement among our student body.

#### Reflection

The pandemic posed formidable obstacles to adhering to the originally scheduled service-learning program. The service activities inherently rely on diverse forms of physical communication and human interaction, which were significantly hampered by pandemic restrictions, causing setbacks in our progress. Nevertheless, the College adeptly pivoted by delivering training and select services online and on a more modest scale.

Importantly, the response from students regarding the service-learning program and its activities was positive. Their valuable feedback has played a pivotal role in enhancing our future program planning, enabling us to tailor it more precisely to their needs and expectations.

#### Feedback and Follow-up

Drawing upon the invaluable experience and the constructive feedback received, the College remains unwavering in its commitment to promoting service-learning and related activities among our students. In the coming school years, it is anticipated a significant expansion of our offerings, with a strong emphasis on increasing student participation.

The resounding success of our previous service-learning endeavors has demonstrated the transformative impact they have on both our students and the communities they serve. Therefore, the College eagers to build upon this foundation and introduce a broader spectrum of activities that not only align with our students' interests but also foster a deep sense of engagement and responsibility.



#### E. Performance of Students

#### 1. Graduates' Pathways


Most of our S6 graduates continued with their further studies in local and overeses universities. 90% of graduates met the local university entrance requirement while 87% of graduates received bachelor's degree offers through JUPAS. 55% of them were given offer to study in the top three universities in Hong Kong, including University of Hong Kong, Chinese University of Hong Kong and Hong Kong University of Science and Technology. Two graduates nominated by the College to the medicine programme through the "School Nomination for Direct Admission Scheme" were accepted by the University of Hong Kong before the released of the HKDSE results. Same as previous years, some graduates admitted the offers from University of Oxford, Imperial College and other universities of the UK and other countries.

#### **S6 Graduates**




#### 2. HKAT (Pre-S1)

#### F. Student Support

#### 1. Evangelistic Work

With the mission to evangelize our students, morning devotion, morning prayer and afterschool prayer meetings are conducted in our school. Guests and ministers of Ying Wa Church are invited to deliver sermons in the evangelistic morning assemblies. In addition, Gospel Week and Gospel Camp are held every year so that our students may come to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ through different means.

The Gospel Week was held in middle November 2022 with a variety of programmes such as evangelistic morning assemblies, gospel band shows and gospel actions. Teachers and students worked together and shared their testimonies how God is still great and faithful even though they walk through the darkest valley.

Some Ying Wa boys joined a Christian leadership training program called "Petros" to establish a brotherhood relationship, cultivate a spiritual growth yearning, equip as youth leaders to serve in campus. We faced various difficulties this academic year but we connected by regular gatherings through video conferencing software during class suspension over pandemic.

"The Blessing CUP 5" soccer championship competition was held in late November 2022. Our teachers and students enjoyed themselves immensely.

Students can have the opportunity to know the gospel through activities, games, worship and other multimedia in junior fellowships and senior fellowships in 2022-23.
