SCHOOL REPORT 2017-2018

A. Our School

1. Brief History of Ying Wa College

Ying Wa College traces her history back to the Anglo-Chinese College founded in Malacca by Rev. Robert Morrison of the London Missionary Society in 1818. The mission of the school was the reciprocal cultivation of English and Chinese literature and the diffusion of Christianity. She trained students to be well versed in both Chinese and Western cultures, so as to help spread the gospel in China.

In 1843 when Hong Kong became the colony of Britain, Rev. James Legge brought the school to Hong Kong where she continued her educational, translation, and publishing activities. Since then, the school had experienced various internal and external difficulties, leading to repeated instances of closure and then reopening with renewed vigor. At present, Ying Wa remains one of the schools having the longest history in Hong Kong.

2. Sponsoring Body

Ying Wa College is an Anglo-Chinese secondary school for boys. She was originally founded by the London Missionary Society. When the London Missionary Society ended her mission in China, the school was affiliated with the Hong Kong Council of the Church of Christ in China, Hong Kong Chapter.

3. Board of Directors

The Ying Wa College School Management Committee Limited was set up in 2009 to meet the need of DSS. There are now altogether 19 members in the Board of Directors including 10 members elected by and representing the Hong Kong Council of the Church of Christ in China, 2 members elected by and representing the Ying Wa College Old Boys' Association, 1 teacher representative, 1 parent representative, the Principal and 4 independent members.

1. Class Organization and Enrolment

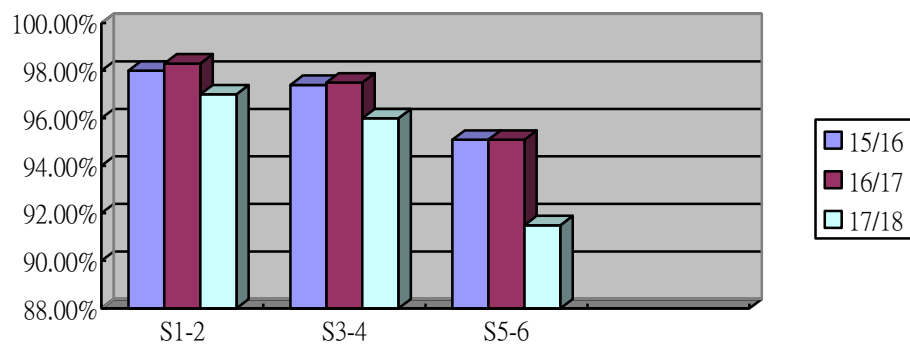
The academic year 2017-2018 began with a total of 1123 students registered for 36 operating classes.

There were 204 DSS students in S1, 203 in S2, 192 in S3, 173 in S4, 64 in S5 and 58 in S6, accounting for 79.6% of the student population.

2. Students' Attendance

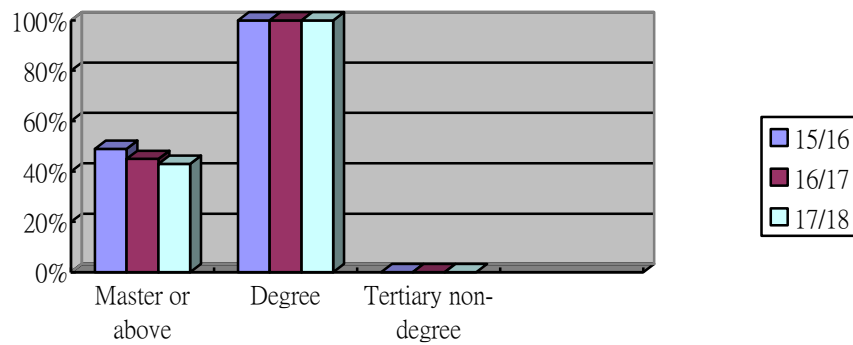

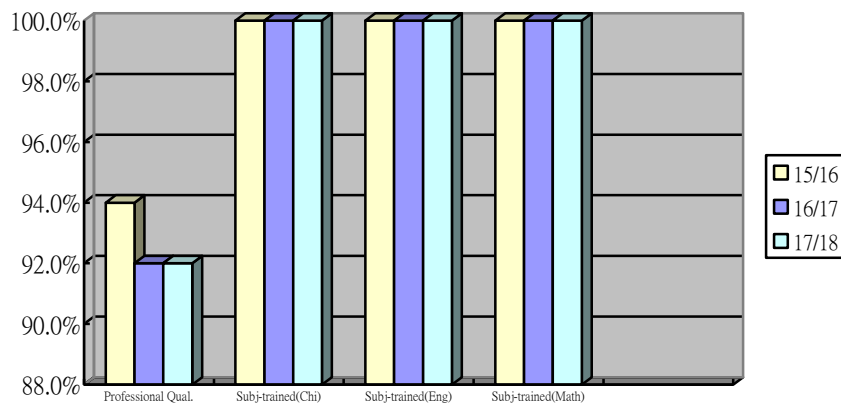
C. Our Teachers

1. Teachers' Qualification

The School has a strong team of 89 dedicated and professional teachers including 2 net teachers and 4 assistant teachers to support classroom teaching and student development initiatives. All of our teachers are graduates from university with 38 teachers holding at least one master's degree.

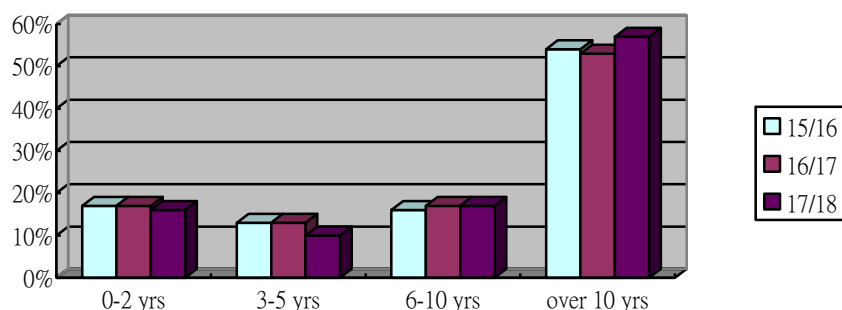


Over 92% of our teachers have received professional training in Education. All teachers teaching Chinese, English and Mathematics are subject-trained.

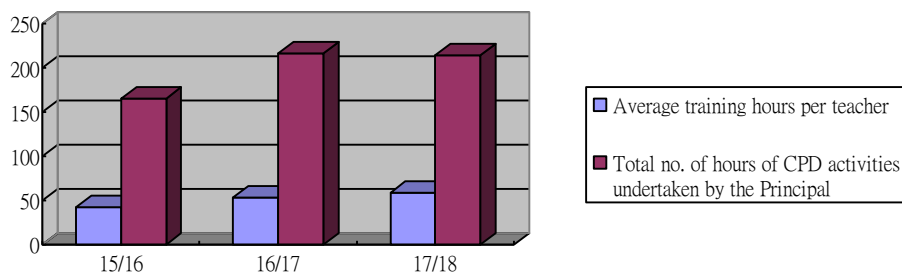


2. Teachers' Experience

3. Teachers' Professional Development



Before the start of the academic year 2017-18, 12 new teachers attended a whole day induction workshop to familiarize themselves with Ying Wa culture as well as school measures and policies. They also received information technology training. Our student ambassadors gave a warm welcome to them and introduced our school campus. A mentor was assigned to each new teacher. New teachers also attended a “newly-employed teachers forum” organized by HKCCCC later on. CCC schools vision, mission and core values were shared.

To enhance the school management, all middle managers had attended a staff development session organized by Broadlearning Education (Asia) in Aug, 2017, the theme was ‘IT applications on School Administration’. Staff benefited much in the use of new eclass functions.

Two staff retreat days were launched in Feb and in March to formulate a new school 5 year plan. Firstly, Principal introduced the road YingWa had walked in the past decades, all teaching staff then actively participated in the activities, gave out their opinions and voiced their concern about the vision and mission of YingWa. Later, school collected all opinions and drafted out a coming 5 year YingWa plan.

In the school year 2017-18, the total number of hours of CPD activities undertaken by the Principal were **214.5** hours and the average training hours per teacher were **58.48** hours.

4. Staff Turnover Rate

At the end of the academic year, 5 teachers (except for Assistant Teachers and Substitute Teachers) left Ying Wa. The school expressed her gratitude to them for their contribution to the school and wished them all the best.

The turnover rate was 5.8%. The turnover rates for the past 3 years are as follows:

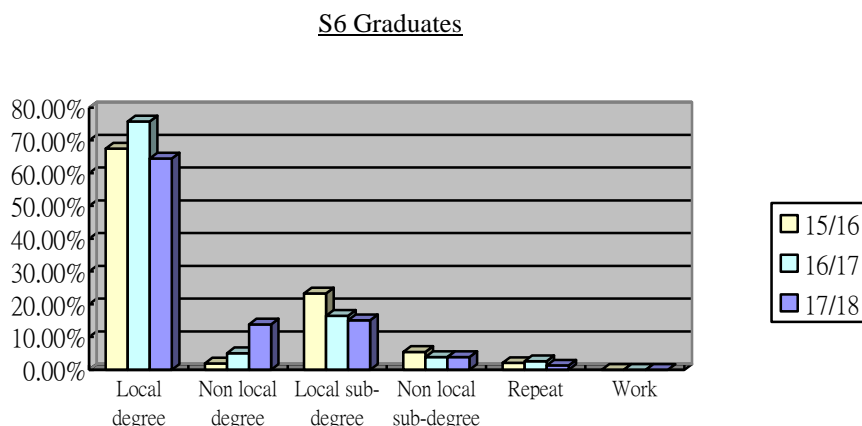

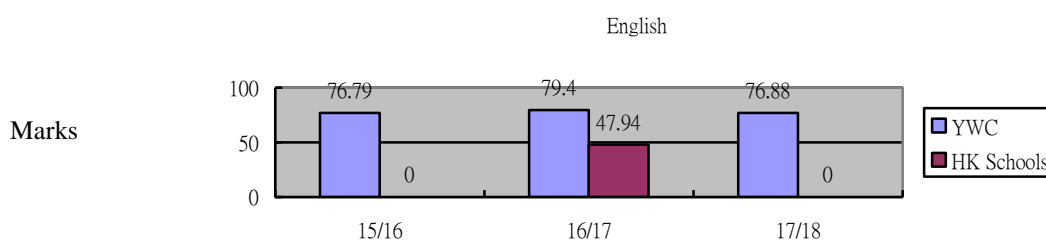
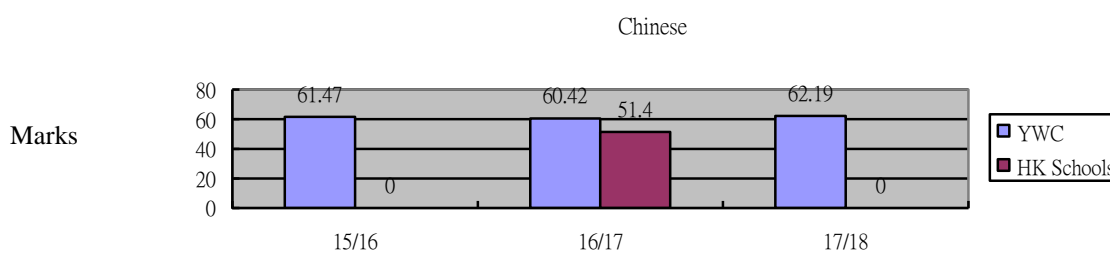
1. Graduates' Pathways

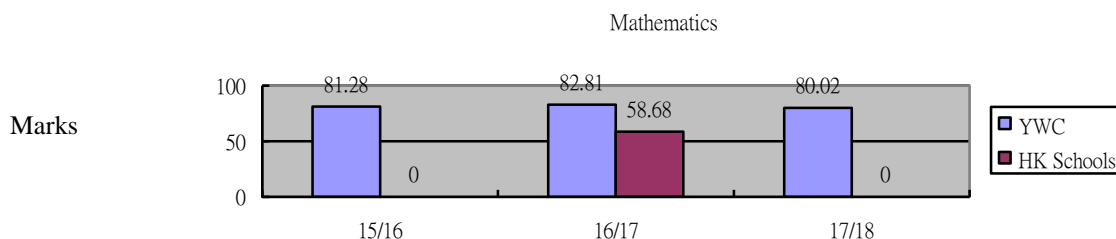
Most of our S6 graduates are offered degrees and sub-degrees, either local or overseas. In 2017-18, the rate was 97.37%.



2. HKAT (Pre-S1)

The average HKAT (Pre-S1) scores of our S1 students in the three core subjects showed an improvement in Chinese but a slight drop in English and Mathematics for the 17/18 academic years compared to those of last year. No figures were provided for the HK Schools by EDB for the 15/16 and 17/18 academic years.

4. Student Participation in Inter-school Events and Uniform Groups

Over 60% of our students participated in inter-school events including the School Music Festival, the School Speech Festival and the inter-school sports events organised by the Hong Kong Schools Sports Federation.

Almost one-tenth of our students participated in uniform groups including Boy Scouts and Hong Kong Red Cross in the year 17/18.

F. Student Support

1. Evangelistic Work

With the mission to evangelize to our students, student fellowship, morning devotion and morning prayer meetings are conducted in our school. Guests and ministers of Ying Wa Church are invited to deliver sermons in the evangelistic morning assemblies. In addition, the Christian Fellowship, Gospel Week and Gospel Camp are held every year so that our students may come to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ through various means.

The Gospel Week was held in November 2017. The programmes included evangelistic morning assemblies, gospel band show, gospel movie sharing and book fairs, especially teachers and students work together and share their testimonies how God is great and genuine.

The Summer Gospel Camp was held from 2 July to 5 July 2017 at YMCA Wong Yi Chau Youth Camp. Not only students of Ying Wa College, but also our teachers and alumni joined the camp. A sense of camaraderie was manifested.

Some Ying Wa boys joined local community services and a Christian leadership training program called “Remnants” (*implied: Significant minority*), to establish a brotherhood relationship, cultivate a spiritual growth yearning, equip as a youth leader to serve in campus.

To encourage students to share and live out their faith every day, a Gospel Soccer Team called “Kairos” (meaning “opportune time for action” in Greek) has been established. In September 2017, the first “Blessing CUP” soccer championship competition was held in our renewed football pitch and our teachers and students enjoyed themselves immensely.

May the Lord be glorified and His blessings be with us.

2. Cultural Exchange

In order to widen students’ horizons and develop their potential, the school welcomed visitors, educationalists and musicians from Hong Kong and other countries to promote cultural exchange.
