SCHOOL REPORT 2024-2025

A. Our School

1. Brief History of Ying Wa College

Ying Wa College traces her history back to the Anglo-Chinese College founded in Malacca by Rev. Robert Morrison of the London Missionary Society in 1818. The mission of the school was the reciprocal cultivation of English and Chinese literature and the diffusion of Christianity. She trained students to be well versed in both Chinese and Western cultures, so as to help spread the gospel in China.

In 1843 when Hong Kong became the colony of Britain, Rev. James Legge brought the school to Hong Kong where she continued her educational, translation, and publishing activities. Since then, the school had experienced various internal and external difficulties, leading to repeated instances of closure and then reopening with renewed vigor. At present, Ying Wa remains one of the schools having the longest history in Hong Kong.

2. Sponsoring Body

Ying Wa College is an Anglo-Chinese secondary school for boys. She was originally founded by the London Missionary Society. When the London Missionary Society ended her mission in China, the school was affiliated with the Hong Kong Council of the Church of Christ in China, Hong Kong Chapter.

3. Board of Directors

The Ying Wa College School Management Committee Limited was set up in 2009. There are now altogether 19 members in the Board of Directors including 10 members appointed by the School Sponsoring body, the Hong Kong Council of the Church of Christ in China, 4 members nominated by the Ying Wa College Old Boys' Association, 1 teacher representative, 1 parent representative, the Principal and 2 independent members.

1. Class Organization and Enrolment


The academic year 2024-2025 began with a total of 1104 students registered for 34 operating classes.

2. Students' Attendance




C. Our Teachers

1. Teachers' Qualification

The School has a strong team of 88 dedicated and professional teachers, including 2 NET teachers to support classroom teaching and student development initiatives. All of our teachers are graduates from university with 37 teachers holding at least one master's degree.




Over 92% of our teachers have received professional training in Education. All teachers teaching Chinese, English and Mathematics are subject-trained.




2. Teachers' Experience

3. Teachers' Professional Development



Before the start of the academic year 2024-25, 12 new teachers attended a half day induction workshop to familiarize themselves with Ying Wa culture as well as school measures and policies. Our student ambassadors gave a warm welcome to them and introduced our school campus. A mentor was assigned to each new teacher. New teachers also attended a “newly-employed teacher’s forum” organized by HKCCCC later on. CCC schools vision, mission and core values were shared.

On December 20, 2024, our school held a Staff Development Day, arranging for over 100 teachers and school office staffs to visit Macau. In the morning, we attended a worship service at the CCC Chi To Church, which helped our staff understand the situation regarding evangelical work and youth programs in Macau. Afterwards, we visited the old protestant cemetery of Dr. Robert Morrison at the Camões Square, in remembrance of our school's founder. In the afternoon, staffs participated in a workshop at the Roosevelt Hotel in Macau to strengthen teamwork.

On February 28, 2025, our school organized a stress relief workshop for all teachers. The activities included coffee tasting, yoga, music, and art therapy, allowing teachers to choose their preferred activities to support their emotional and mental health, and to encourage a mutually supportive atmosphere.

From May to June 2025, our school's PE team hosted a bowling training class, with over 30 staffs participating. The program taught basic bowling skills and included group competitions, allowing employees to relax and fostering a spirit of teamwork.

In the school year 2024-25, the total number of hours of CPD activities undertaken by the Principal was 130 hours and the average training hours per teacher were 26 hours. The training on the Basic Law is 1.7 hours on average.

4. Staff Turnover Rate

At the end of the academic year, 13 teachers (except for Assistant Teachers and Substitute Teachers) left Ying Wa. The school expressed her gratitude to them for their contribution to the school and wished them all the best.

D. Major Concerns

Major Concern 1: To grow capable and decent young gentlemen

Achievements <p>During the 2024-2025 school year, we demonstrated our dedication to student growth through the active promotion of the Ying Wa Values Statement. This core principle was not only reaffirmed but also prominently featured in our classrooms and mass talks, fostering a collective understanding among students and staff. Acknowledging the necessity of preparing students with vital skills for the 21st century, we organized a diverse range of development activities designed to empower them to succeed in a rapidly changing world.</p> <p>Subject departments and committees introduced the Ying Wa Values to our stakeholders on various occasions, allowing us to reflect on our impact. Our year-round student development program, DELTA X, has received positive feedback from students, teachers, parents, and alumni. For instance, the integration of Careers Day for S.5 students as part of the DELTA X program, alongside activities ranging from university visits to job shadowing, enabled many students to benefit from insights shared by our alumni and partners. The OLE Committee has initiated sharing sessions with other committees responsible for student leadership programs to encourage S3 and S4 students to take on more responsibilities within the school. Additionally, our Smart Generation program, coordinated by the Guidance Committee for junior forms, has provided regular opportunities to address the developmental needs of students at different stages.</p>
Reflection <p>Reflecting on these initiatives, we recognize the importance of ongoing collaboration and adaptation to meet the evolving needs of our community. The increasing collaboration among committees on student development initiatives has strengthened our collective efforts, receiving overwhelmingly positive feedback from stakeholders. Our successful partnerships between Ying Wa College (YWC), Ying Wa Primary School (YWPS), the Old Boys' Association (OBA), and the Parent-Teacher Association (PTA) have been evident through numerous engaging activities. Notable initiatives include the scarf knitting workshop, "It's Your Turn! Donate" (招織暖男培訓班), organized by the Service-Learning Committee and the Home-School Cooperation Committee, as well as the 中華文化飲食週, a collaboration between the PTA and the Moral, Civic and National Education Committee to promote National Education through Chinese traditional cuisine. Furthermore, we have arranged various activities addressing the 4Rs for our students, teachers, and staff, including relaxation workshops hosted by our school social workers, ensuring that the school community is well-equipped to support student growth.</p>
Feedback and Follow-up <p>We aim to build on the experiences and successes of the first two years by further enhancing our student development initiatives. Plans are underway to deepen the integration of the Ying Wa Values into both our academic and non-academic curricula. We will continue to strengthen our collaborative efforts among YWC, YWPS, OBA, PTA, and other community NGOs to develop school-based programs that are well-suited for our students.</p>

Major Concern 2: To widen students' learning experience through diversified opportunities

Achievements

In the inaugural year of the James Legge Culturati Award Scheme (理雅各文化研習獎勵計劃), we witnessed an overwhelming response from our student body, with over 660 entries from student participation in various culture-related activities, competitions, visits, and local and overseas study tours. This initiative aimed to promote cultural learning and engagement, and it has certainly achieved its goal. A total of 78 students were recognized for their outstanding contributions, with awards distributed across diverse subject areas including Chinese, Chinese History, English, Computer Science, History, the Library, the OLE Committee, Visual Arts, Music, and Geography. The students not only participated enthusiastically but also produced high-quality reflection reports that showcased their learning experiences. This collaborative effort from various departments underscores our commitment to fostering a vibrant cultural environment within the school.

In our efforts to enhance learner autonomy and the relevance of learning, we introduced pre- and post-lesson strategies, notably the KWL chart. This approach encourages students to take ownership of their learning journey by transitioning from teacher-directed learning goals to self-exploration and summarization of topics. In the junior forms, Integrated Science enhances student engagement by integrating the KWL framework, collecting "What I want to know" questions at the start of each module, and promoting student-led research presentations shared in Google Classroom and the classroom. In senior forms, subjects such as Citizenship & Social Development and Religious Education have successfully integrated the KWL chart into their daily teaching practices and school-based handouts for each teaching module. The Chinese Department has launched student-led studies of classic Chinese texts in different forms, in which students conducted their own research and presented their text analysis to their peers during lessons.

Most teachers have increased their awareness of activating students' prior knowledge, making connections between what they learned previously and the new content of the current year. As a result, students generally show enhanced ownership, demonstrating better attitudes in their assignments and class performance.

Furthermore, the learning reflection report templates under the James Legge Culturati Award Scheme embody the spirit of KWL, guiding students in reflecting on their learning experiences through activities beyond the classroom. This initiative not only fosters self-directed learning but also reinforces the connection between classroom instruction and real-world applications, enabling students to critically analyze their experiences and articulate their learning processes for deeper understanding.

Various local, mainland, and overseas visits and tours have enhanced students' subject knowledge as well as raised their awareness of different global sustainable development issues and national security.

Our first S4 hybrid class has been launched successfully. Students generally showed strong motivation in their studies and clear academic goals for their IGCSEs. Our new squad of teachers for the IGCSE curriculum are young and dedicated. They have laid a solid foundation for the advancement of the IAL curriculum in the coming years.

Reflection

The James Legge Culturati Award Scheme has not only effectively created an atmosphere of cultural appreciation and awareness among students but has also fostered collaboration across different subject areas and committees in organizing outings and study tours. Similarly, the essence of the KWL chart as a pre-, during-, and post-learning strategy was clearly communicated to subject heads and teachers in staff meetings, academic and subject heads meetings, and subject panel meetings. The shared belief and concerted efforts among subject and committee heads proved crucial, as we observed them going the extra mile to connect their subject-based activities with the school's major concerns. Furthermore, allowing individual subjects to incorporate the essence of KWL in ways that best fit their context contributes to the teachers' sense of ownership and the overall effectiveness of new initiatives.

Feedback and Follow-up

As we move forward, it is essential to continue and expand upon the two initiatives—the James Legge Culturati Award Scheme and the KWL chart strategies. Maintaining these programs will not only solidify their impact but also provide opportunities for further enhancement.

To deepen students' ownership of their learning, more lesson time can be set aside for KWL student-led presentations (e.g., module consolidation and self-directed research/enquiry studies) to encourage students to present their learning journeys to peers and teachers, fostering accountability and pride in their achievements.

To strengthen communication with subject heads, we will establish regular check-ins (e.g., AC and SHKLACC meetings) to discuss the implementation of KWL strategies and the progress of the Culturati Award Scheme. These can serve as a platform for sharing successes, challenges, and best practices. Additionally, we can create a monitoring system that tracks student engagement and performance related to these initiatives, allowing us to identify areas for improvement and celebrate achievements.

Subject panels are encouraged to incorporate the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and National Education and National Security Elements more frequently into their curricula to raise students' awareness of global sustainable development issues, fostering critical thinking and engagement with real-world challenges.


Major Concern 3: To enhance school's operational efficiency and effectiveness

Achievements
After a thorough review and discussion within the Leadership Team, and following opinions collected through SEDC Meetings and consultation with all teaching staff, the policy on Staff Promotion was reviewed, revised, and implemented starting in April 2025. Fine-tuning and clarification will be made when needed. The revised Performance Appraisal Cycle is in its second year, with some fine-tuning still ongoing. We further migrated different paperwork to electronic platforms, such as the use of the Medical Room, the Assembly Booking System, and the guidance cases referral system. Training continued to be provided to teachers on the use of electronic devices and the newly installed e-blackboards.
Reflection
Various capital improvement projects were successfully carried out to enhance the school environment. We have also upgraded all the remaining classrooms from traditional blackboards to interactive electronic blackboards to enhance the learning and teaching experiences for senior forms. Moreover, another one-third of staff computer systems were renewed.
Feedback and Follow-up
To prepare for the full implementation of the IAL curriculum and the increase in student enrolment in 2026-27, more capital improvement projects and enhancement work will continue in 2025-26. To further streamline the administrative work of teachers and free up time for teaching staff to focus on learning and teaching activities, we will hire full-time staff to support careers guidance work. To further install of e-blackboards in the classrooms of senior classes and explore the use of AI in supporting the administrative work.



1. Graduates' Pathways


Most of our S6 graduates are offered degrees and sub-degrees, either local or overseas. In 2024-25, the rate was 96.69%.

F. Student Support

1. Evangelistic Work

With the mission to evangelize our students, morning devotion, morning prayer and luncheon prayer meetings and fellowships are conducted in our school. Guests and ministers of Ying Wa Church are invited to deliver sermons in the evangelistic morning assemblies. In addition, Gospel Week and Gospel Camp are held every year so that our students may know more about Jesus Christ through different means.

The Gospel Week was held in mid-November 2024 with a variety of programmes such as evangelistic morning assemblies, gospel band shows and gospel actions. Teachers and students worked together and shared their testimonies how God is still great and faithful even though they walk through the darkest valley.

Some students joined a bible study group in the morning before lessons start to establish a brotherhood relationship, cultivate a spiritual growth yearning, equip as youth leaders to serve in campus. In collaboration with The Salvation Army, students who regularly joined the Christian fellowship were invited to visit the homeless in Shamshuipo as a channel of bringing God's love and peace to the people in need.

"The Blessing Cup 7" soccer championship competition was held in late November 2024. Our teachers and students enjoyed themselves immensely.

Students can have the opportunity to know the gospel through activities, games, worship and other multimedia in Alpha Youth series during lunchtime in 2024-25.

3. Support for Students with Special Educational Needs

The school is committed to inclusive education policies, integrating students with Special Educational Needs (SEN) into various classes while promoting respect and acceptance of diverse characteristics through various activities.

To facilitate integration, we adopt the Three-tier Intervention Model. At Tier 1, early identification and catering are provided for all students with diverse learning and adjustment needs through quality teaching in regular classrooms. Tier 2 focuses on additional support and intervention, such as small group training, for those with persistent learning difficulties, and Tier 3 involves individualized intensive support for students with persistent and severe learning or adjustment difficulties. Effective communication with parents is essential for developing appropriate adjustments, such as special assessment arrangements and tailored homework modifications.

In 2024/2025, the school received the Learning Support Grant with a sum of \$1,019,455. The school has effectively utilized the grant for hiring staff, purchasing services, and conducting training groups to support approximately 80 students with SEN and others in need.

We have hired a Student Development Officer to implement inclusive education activities, strengthen the transition between primary and secondary schools, and foster a positive culture that helps students adapt to campus life and improve social skills. A Student Support Assistant has also been employed to facilitate these activities, provide individualized support, handle administrative tasks, and enhance communication with parents.

Additionally, we offer clinical psychology services and various social groups, including ASD and ADHD social skills groups, to improve focus, rule-following, and interpersonal relationships. Chinese reading and writing groups aim to enhance exam skills, while homework tutoring groups assist students with their assignments. Inclusive activities, such as Dodgebee, tennis, floor hockey, and bowling training sessions, further promote focus, teamwork, and a culture of inclusivity.
